Under the supervision of Dr. Caroline Hillyard, three Level 2 OT students have been onsite 5 days a week providing one-on-one therapy with our students to meet personal health goals, improve dexterity, build strength and movement, and more. The Belmont OT students are side by side with BrightStone students – building independence, confidence, and life skills.



STRONGER TOGETHER COMMUNITY HEALTH FAIR

In early October, the Stronger Together Community Health Fair was held, providing free health screenings for those ages 5 and older with intellectual and developmental disabilities. Groundwork for New Residential Homes is Underway!



For adults with intellectual and developmental disabilities (IDD), the dream of an independent, fulfilling life in a supportive community is often out of reach. At the Land of Dreams campus, we are building a first-of-its-kind community in Tennessee where those dreams become reality. In 2022, we opened our first two residential homes. Now, we are ready to make more dreams come true for families in need of a home for their adult child.

With \$2,377,547 already raised toward our \$4 million Homecoming Capital Campaign goal, we have been working diligently to have the infrastructure for our next phase of residential homes prepared. This infrastructure is nearing completion and, with your support, we will begin construction on our next homes. These homes will provide eight more residents a life of further independence in a beautiful, loving, and supportive environment.

BrightStone is now the only organization in Middle Tennessee legally authorized to offer adults with IDD residential options in a campus setting. Last year, BrightStone was selected by the Tennessee Governor as a Pilot Residential Program. We are approved to build more homes and are establishing the first campus of its kind in Tennessee – serving as a model program nationwide for supportive, campus-based living.
