

## BrightStone Job Description

**Title: Bus Driver, part-time morning shift**

**FLSA: Non-Exempt/Hourly**

**Reports To: Transportation Coordinator**

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### **Position Summary:**

As a BrightStone Bus Driver you are responsible for providing adult students quality and safe transportation to and from the campus and to and from the community as a licensed, safe, and cautious driver. You will be expected to reliably arrive on time each day to perform all activities required to safely drive a BrightStone vehicle transporting adults with special needs and other authorized personnel to and from BrightStone and BrightStone events.

### **Principal Duties and Responsibilities:**

- Operates vehicle in compliance with all traffic and safety laws and regulations, exhibiting defensive driving habits and observing posted speed limits
- Transport students on an assigned route according to a defined schedule to and from BrightStone and their homes in the mornings which may require driving during pre-daylight and dusk periods
- Transport students to and from routine community based activities including jobs, recreation, library, and other adult activities
- Transport students on field trips, other sanctioned outings, athletic contests, and community events
- Monitors riders for potentially dangerous riding situations; Watches for and confiscates sharp or dangerous objects; Reports riders who break posted rules
- Monitors orderly entering/exiting the bus. Takes appropriate safety precautions as students are boarding and departing
- Safely operates the wheelchair lift and safely loads students and chairs on and off vehicle
- Daily inspects the bus and checks fuel, oil, water, lights, brakes, and steering according to the Daily Inspection Sheet in the Transportation Manual
- Regulates heating and ventilating equipment provided on the bus for the comfort of passengers before driving
- Identifies needs and arranges for repairs and maintenance according to the Routine Inspection Sheet in Transportation Manual

- Immediately reports all accidents to BrightStone's Director of Programs and law enforcement officials. Handles emergency situations according to BrightStone's protocol and procedures, including stabilizing the situation and attending to the needs of the students until assistance can be obtained. May implement emergency evacuations to include assisting students to evacuate the bus and provide safe transport.
- Maintains records of bus mileage, gas and oil consumption, and the number of passengers transported.
- Clean the bus inside and out, as needed.
- Perform other related duties as required.

### **Minimum Training and Experience Required**

- Must have a clear driving record
- Must have a CDL Class B w/ P endorsement and medical card
- Complete and pass a criminal background check and drug screening

### **Skills and Abilities Required**

- Possess the ability to relate positively to students with intellectual and developmental disabilities
- Function as part of a multi-disciplinary team
- The successful candidate will have a servant's heart and sound judgment while being tactful and caring
- Communicate clearly utilizing verbal and written skills
- Possess analytical problem-solving and sound judgment skills
- Ability to stand for long periods of time
- Ability to lift up to 50 pounds
